### **KDSB to assist ODSP and ASCD in delivering benefits**

The Kenora District Services Board (KDSB) would like to inform residents who receive Ontario Works assistance that cheques will be mailed as usual following notification that Canada Post back-to-work legislation has come into effect, ending rotating postal strikes. However, the KDSB will be assisting Ontario Disability Support Program (ODSP) and Assistance for Children with Severe Disabilities (ASCD) recipients who receive their payment by cheque in delivering benefits in Dryden and Sioux Lookout.

Recipients who receive their ODSP or ASCD payment by cheque and are located in Dryden or Sioux Lookout are asked to pick up their benefits in-person at their local KDSB office. KDSB staff will be available on Friday, November 30<sup>th</sup> from 8:00 am to 4:30 pm.
