### **Call for proposals open for Social Services Relief Fund – Food Security Stream**

Through the Government of Ontario's Social Services Relief Fund, the Kenora District Services Board (KDSB) is seeking Food Security Stream proposals that will prevent the lack of access to healthy, nutritious food for individuals and families in the Kenora District during the COVID-19 Pandemic.

Project proposals that demonstrate community coordination with more than one partner will be given priority.

“The inequities that our communities face is being amplified by the financial impacts of this Pandemic. If households do not have an adequate income currently, it becomes challenging to achieve an optimal level of food security. Through the Social Services Relief Fund, we are working with the Government of Ontario to ensure that community organizations can assist families and individuals, so they do not need to worry where their next meal will come from,” says Henry Wall, Chief Administrative Officer of the KDSB.
